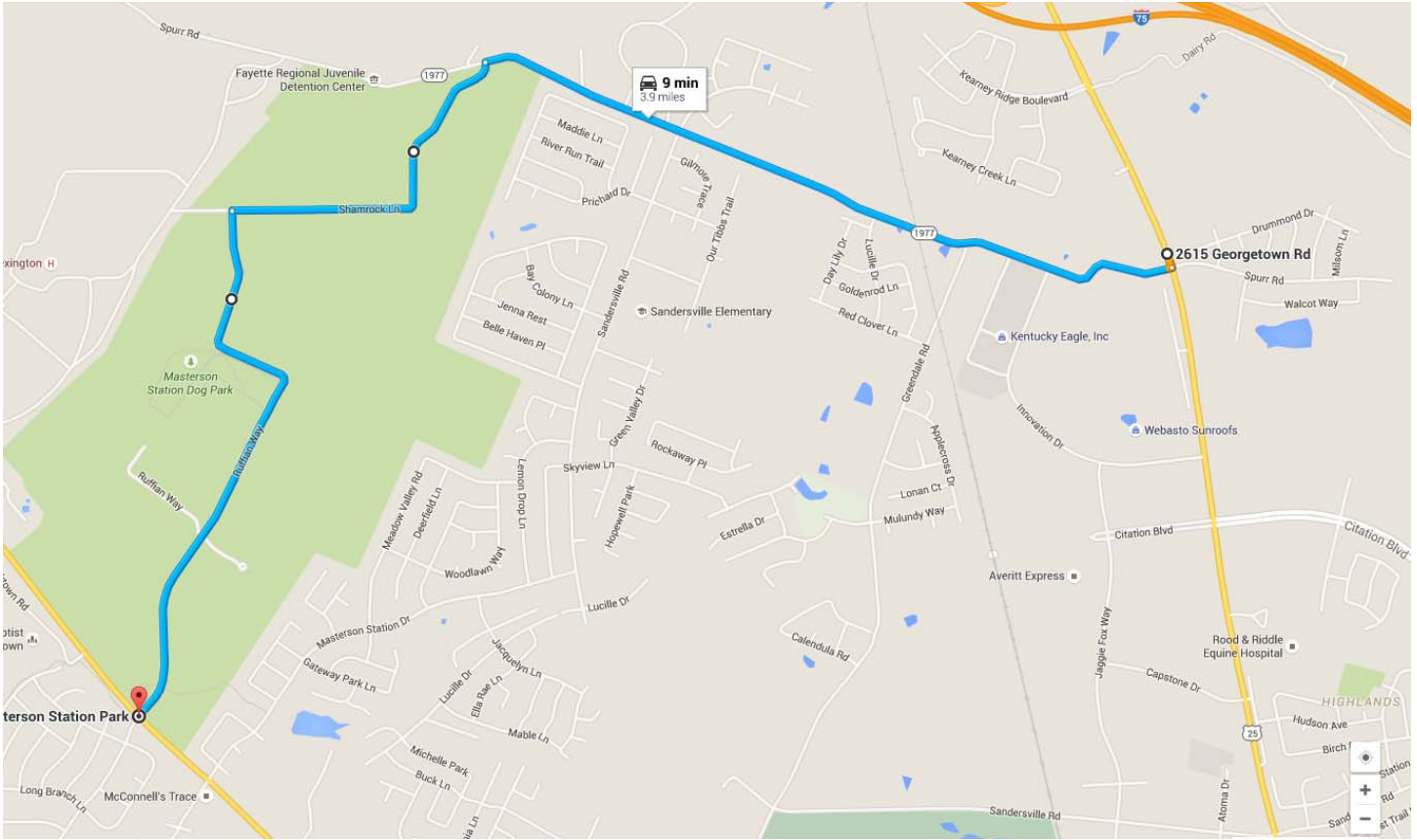

Market Goat Show Rules

1. See the general rules applying to the Lions Bluegrass Fair Livestock Market Shows.
2. Both market wether and doe kids are eligible for show.
3. All market goats must be owned by and in the physical possession of the exhibitor on or before May 31, 2018.
4. An exhibitor may show no more than two animals per class and a total of 6 animals in the market goat show.
5. Goats should be on the grounds by 4:00 pm EDT on Tuesday, July 18th. Weigh-in will begin at 4:30pm EDT. Judging will begin at 6:00 pm EDT.
6. Goats will be shown by weight.
7. No artificial color or muzzles are allowed on goats at any time.
8. Showmanship classes will be determined by year of birth of the exhibitor.
9. Exhibitors must show their own animal in showmanship class.
10. Market wether kids must be clean castrated which is defined as testicles having been surgically removed, not clamped.
11. Horns are optional but must be tipped if present. Tipped is defined as: the end of the horn squared off to at least ½ inch in diameter or larger. The end of the horn should be healed and not bleeding.
12. Old Geezer showmanship contest for 35 and up during showmanship contest. No entry fee required.



Alternate Entrance



- Head south on Georgetown Rd toward Spurr Rd - 174 ft
- Turn right at the 1st cross street onto KY-1977/Spurr Rd - 1.7 mi
- Turn left onto Shamrock Ln - 0.8 mi
- Turn left onto Ruffian Way - 1.3 mi
- Follow the paved road and look for the 4-H signs
- Now at Masterson Station Park
