As a Homemaker, you can:

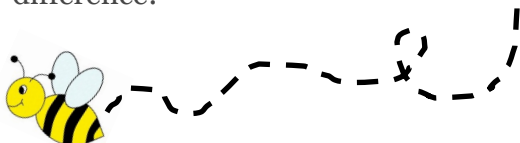
