



Balsamic Veggie Pasta

Servings: 4 Serving Size: 2 cups







Ingredients:

- · 4 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- · 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 small zucchini, chopped
- 1 small yellow squash, chopped
- 2 tomatoes, chopped
- ½ cup green onions, chopped
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
- 1 teaspoon dried basil
- 8 ounces whole wheat pasta
- 1 tablespoon Parmesan, grated

Directions:

- 1. In large skillet, heat 1 tablespoon olive oil over medium heat.
- Add minced garlic and cook one minute, until fragrant.
- 3. Add chopped zucchini, squash, tomatoes, and green onions, and cook until tender.
- 4. Add salt and pepper to taste.
- 5. In a large bowl, whisk together 3 tablespoons olive oil, balsamic vinegar, and dried basil.
- 6. Stir in zucchini, squash, tomatoes, and green onions.
- 7. Let sit for 5 to 10 minutes.
- 8. In a large pot, cook pasta in salted water about 7 minutes, until al dente.
- 9. Drain.
- Toss pasta with vegetable mixture until incorporated.
- 11. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese. Serve warm.
