It is with a heavy heart and eyes full of tears that I write to you to let you know that January 31st will be my last day with 4-H in Fayette County.



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




Slow Cooker Chicken Santa Fe Soup

Servings: 8 Serving Size: 2 cups









- · 4 thawed boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- 1 (7 ounce) can chopped green chilies
- 1 (8 ounce) bag frozen corn
- · 1 (28 ounce) can diced tomatoes, no salt added
- 1 (15 ounce) can black beans
- 1 (14 ounce) can or box vegetable broth, no salt added
- 1 (32 ounce) box low-sodium chicken broth
- 3 tablespoons low sodium chili seasoning mix

Directions:

- 1. Place all ingredients in slow cooker and simmer on low 6-8 hours or 3-4 hours on high.
- 2. Remove cooked chicken and shred with two forks.
- 3. Return chicken to soup and it is ready-to-serve.
