November 12, 2024: Forever Belle: Sallie Ward of Kentucky by Randolph Paul Runyon Forever Belle is the intriguing story of a nineteenth-century socialite, Sallie Ward Lawrence Hunt Armstrong Downs (1827–1896). Beautiful, charming, and kind—but also reckless and bold—she was born in Scott County, Kentucky, to a family of means beset by tragedy—early deaths, suicides, and even murders. Sallie basked in the national spotlight, appearing in newspapers as far-flung as Milwaukee and Charleston, written up for her exploits, which included such scandalous behavior as smoking cigars, dressing in "Turkish pantalets," wearing rouge, and getting divorced.

Fall Spiced Pumpkin Bread

1/2 cup all-purpose flour 1/4 cup whole-wheat flour

1½ teaspoons baking powder

1 teaspoon baking soda

2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice ½ teaspoon salt

1/2 cup melted margarine

margarine 1/2 cup sugar ½ cup honey
2 cups pumpkin puree
⅓ cup olive oil
2 eggs
⅓ cup chopped

walnuts

Heat oven to 350 degrees F. Mix flours, baking powder, baking soda, pumpkin spice and salt; set aside. In a large mixing bowl, whisk together margarine, sugar, honey, pumpkin puree and olive oil. Blend in eggs. Add flour mixture. Stir until dry ingredients are moistened. Spray a 8-by-4 inch loaf pan with non-stick cooking spray. Pour batter into pan; sprinkle walnuts on top of batter. Bake for 1 hour. Remove from oven

and cover with foil. Return to oven and bake an additional 20 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes and remove from pan.

Yield: 16 slices

Nutritional Analysis: 220 calories, 13 g fat, 2 g saturated fat, 30 mg cholesterol, 270 mg sodium, 26 g carbohydrate, 1 g fiber, 14 g sugars, 4 g protein.

Easy Egg Basket ~ October 22, 2024 ~ 10:00am-4:00pm

This is the perfect learner egg basket - making a God's Eye, inserting ribs, weaving in the ribs and turning back. These are the basics we will learn using dyed and natural reed on 2 8 inch round hoops. Instructor Mary McAllister. Cost: \$54.

English Paper Piecing Hand-Sewing Class ~ October 23, 2024 ~ 4:30-7:30pm In this hand-sewing class, attendees will learn four English Paper Piecing stitching methods. Additionally, you will be able to ask questions and learn sewing information and tips that are not easily found online. Join us as we continue the art of slow stitching and create something beautiful in the process. All supplies are provided in the class but you may also bring fabric from your own stash. Instructor Ashley Nguyen. Cost: \$25.



Sweetness Basket ~ November 26, 204 ~ 10:00am-4:00pm

This is a beautiful small basket measuring 7" inches across with a woven base, a square handle and woven in natural and space dyed Reed. Shaping is the challenge so if you are a tight weaver come prepared. Cost: \$48 Advanced Beginner level. Instructor Mary McAllister.





Stitches Basket ~ December 3, 2024 ~ 10:00am-4:00pm

This basket is woven on a wood base and measures 5" X 8" 10" tall. Woven in natural, smoke and your choice of either cranberry or avocado green. Push-in handle included. Lashing in cane or natural. Cost: \$48 Advanced beginner. Instructor Mary McAllister.

SUPPLIES YOU MUST BRING FOR BASLET CLASSES: Water container (bucket/bowl), small towel, scissors (garden type preferable), small flat head screwdriver, 2 dozen snap type clothespins, tape measure, pencil, pocket knife (good sized), sandpaper, weights (unopened soup cans work) and a small spray bottle. **PACK A LUNCH/SNACKS, or bring something to share. You will be working thru lunch.**




