<b><i>KEHA</i></b>	Kentucky Extension Homemakers Association, Inc.
<b><i>POW</i></b>	For KEHA – Program of Work (applies to the 8 educational chairmen) In Extension – Refers to the county “plan of work”
<b><i>VSU</i></b>	Volunteer Service Unit (KEHA program for tracking volunteer service)
<b><i>MVP</i></b>	Master Volunteer in Clothing Construction Program
<b><i>MFHG</i></b>	Master Farm Homemakers Guild
<b><i>CES</i></b>	Cooperative Extension Service
<b><i>DD</i></b>	District Director
<b><i>NVON</i></b>	National Volunteer Outreach Network (National organization established in 1995 and accepted as an ACWW member in 1998. KEHA was an organizing member.)
<b><i>ACWW</i></b>	Associated Country Women of the World (International organization with which KEHA is affiliated through NVON.)
<b><i>CWC</i></b>	Country Women’s Council U.S.A. (Liaison council composed of ACWW members in the U.S.A.)
<b><i>KEAFCS</i></b>	Kentucky Extension Association of Family & Consumer Sciences
<b><i>EIN</i></b>	Employer Identification Number (same as TIN – issued by the Internal Revenue Service)
<b><i>TIN</i></b>	Tax Identification Number (same as EIN – issued by the Internal Revenue Service)
<b><i>NHDC</i></b>	National Home Demonstration Council (name of first national organization for Homemakers – organized June 1936)
<b><i>NEHC</i></b>	National Extension Homemakers Council (second name for the national organization)
<b><i>NAFCE</i></b>	National Association for Family & Community Education (third name for the national organization – Kentucky disassociated with this group in 1998)
<b><i>FCL</i></b>	Family Community Leadership program
